# WHAT CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE?

Harmony Energy listened carefully to the comments made at the consultation events and has made crucial changes to the scheme to address concerns raised, which include:

- **There will be no construction access to the solar farm from Parkgate Lane** - instead using an existing access off the A6055
- Relocating of panels to minimise impact on neighbouring dwellings
- Pre-emptive planting to allow the establishment of screening of panels ahead of development
- Increase in the provision of community benefit fund over the project's operational life to £20,000 per annum

In addition, other key benefits of the scheme include:

- Producing enough energy to meet the average annual electricity consumption needs of 13,000 homes and create carbon dioxide savings, amounting to just over 14,000 tonnes per year
- Tackling climate change and meeting our Net-Zero targets
- Being built subsidy-free (at no cost to tax payer)
- New habitat creation and wildlife enhancements, providing an overall biodiversity net gain of over 61% habitat units and 11% hedgerow units
